**Parish and Position Information**

The Anglican Church Robina is a thriving church in the Central Gold Coast region. We are currently looking for a full-time Director of Youth, Young Adult & Music Ministry that connects with our church vision and mission, with a desire to build on the foundations already established and prioritise ministry with young people in our church community.

Reporting to the Senior Minister, you will plan and coordinate regular events involving young people, including:

- Mentor and accompany the youth and young adults of the parish
- Coordinate the Sunday program for high school age students
- Coordinate and oversee the Thursday evening youth groups (high school age & young adult)
- Develop new and maintain existing links with local universities, public and private schools
- Build relationships and communicate with families where appropriate
- Lead and direct the music program for our Sunday 9:30am congregation
- Mentor our musically gifted teenage parishioners, encouraging and supporting them as they consider and/or move to becoming regular members of the music team
- Work collaboratively with the parish ministry team and other staff.

**Personal and Professional Requirements**

As our Director of Youth, Young Adult & Music Ministry, you will come with qualifications in Youth Ministry, Theology or a related discipline; be an effective communicator with people of all ages; have a strong understanding of group dynamics; and have the ability to model behaviour, lifestyle and faith formation to young people. A keen desire for your own continuous personal faith development and formation will also be evident.

Ideally, our successful candidate will also have demonstrated experience working with young people and leading worship teams. Strong guitar and/or keyboard skills will be highly regarded, with an understanding of classically trained musicians a plus.

You will hold a valid driver's licence and must be eligible to hold and maintain a Working with Children Blue Card. You must also be willing to become an active member of this church.

Apply today to have the privilege of contributing to and witnessing young people as they cultivate mature relationships with each other and with Jesus, and establish their faith alongside others of the Christian faith.
